

Neither the general assembly, nor any County. City, borough, town or school district shall have power to fear or grant any extra comprusation to any foublic officer, cuployee, agent or servant, or increase the comprusation of any public officer or employee, to take effect during the continuance in office of any person whose palary might be increased thereby, or increase the pay or comprusation of any public contractor above the amount specified in the Contractor
