The moderator shall also seal and deliver one of such duplicate lists to the Secretary of the State not later than the third day after the election. The attached is the Head Moderator's Return for the Municipal Election held for the Town of Bethel on November 7, 2017. This return replaces the return sent to your office by fax on November 9, 2017.

As per our phone conversation with Heather Augeri this afternoon, we are mailing this return to you after finding discrepancies in the return caused by the Election Management System and its programmed formulas related to improperly allocating Unknown Votes. Heather advised us to make updates and corrections to the "Head Moderator's Return By District" which we have done. We are finding that the "Head Moderator Return by District" is still incorrect for Town Clerk in District 4 due to the incorrect allocation of Unknown votes.

The official return with the live signature is attached. On this return, you will see one correction that we made by hand. While the return in each of our voting Districts has been updated and corrected, the final return within EMS still has the incorrect numbers for Lisa Bergh, Town Clerk, due to the EMS programmed formula for party allocation of Unknown votes. Attached is the allocation of Unknown votes from EMS for Lisa Bergh. We have also attached the allocation of Unknown votes from the "Unknown Votes Calculator" found on the Secretary of the State website. You will see that the allocation of Unknown votes on these two pages does not agree.

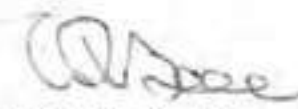

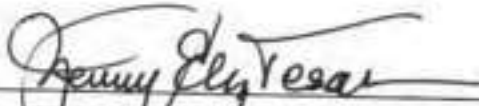
