Once the preliminary list has been transmitted, the moderator shall make a duplicate list of the votes given for each municipal office elected. The moderator shall transmit such duplicate list to the Secretary of the State by electronic means not later than forty-eight hours after the close of the polls on election day. The moderator shall also seal and deliver one of such duplicate lists to the Secretary of the State not later than the third day after the election.
