There are 168 towns in the State — 84 send two representatives and 84 one each, making 252 members of the House; these Towns are divided into 24 Senatorial Districts; and the eight Counties into 4 Congressional Districts.

Hartford County has 4 Senators and 45 Representatives.

New Haven County has 4 Senators and 36 Representatives.

New London County has 3 Senators and 30 Representatives.

Fairfield County has 4 Senators and 32 Representatives.

Windham County has 2 Senators and 24 Representatives.

Litchfield County has 3 Senators and 41 Representatives.

Middlesex County has 2 Senators and 22 Representatives.

Tolland County has 2 Senators and 22 Representatives.
