Nathan D. Bates vs. Oliver A. Raymond

State of Connecticut, County of New London ss.
 In the matter of the within petition of Nathan D. Bates of Boston in said county of New London, against Oliver A. Raymond of Norwich in said county. The said petition having been duly served upon the said Oliver A. Raymond on the first day of December A.D. 1877, at least two days before the day of the return therein mentioned, and having been returned on the same day to me, James A. Henry, a judge of the Superior Court, the said parties appeared before me at the office of the Clerk of said court in the town of Norwich in said county on the third day of December A.D. 1877, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, and afterwards on the same day at the Superior Court room in said Norwich, and afterwards at the same Court room on the seventh, eighth, and fifteenth days of December A.D. 1877; and having fully heard the said parties with their evidence touching the matters set forth and alleged in said petition, I do find that at the meetings of the electors in the several towns of said county, held on Tuesday following the first Monday of November A.D. 1877, that is to say, on the sixth day of November A.D. 1877, the said parties respectively received a higher number of votes for the office of Sheriff of said county than any other person; that the whole number of votes received by the said Bates for said office in all of the towns in said county, was four thousand six hundred and sixty-three, [4663] and that the whole number of votes received by the said Raymond for said office in all of the towns of said county, was four thousand six hundred and fifty-seven, [4657]. I do, therefore, find, adjudge and decide, that the said Nathan D. Bates was, on the sixth day of November A.D. 1877, duly and legally elected to the office of Sheriff of the county of New London, for the term of three years, commencing June 1st, A.D. 1878.

In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand this eighteenth day of December A.D. 1877.
